	Image	Key Verses	Description of the chapter image
Chapter 1	"The Word"	John 1:1	An image of "Word" in both English and Greek
Chapter 2	Jars being filled	John 2:7-10	Story of Jesus turning water to wine at the wedding in Cana, Jesus' first recorded miracle
Chapter 3	Pregnant woman	John 3:4-7	"You must be born again" from Jesus' conversation with Nicodemus
Chapter 4	Water well	John 4:7-10	Jesus talks to the Samaritan woman at the well
Chapter 5	5 columns	John 5:2-9	Jesus heals the invalid at the pool of Bethesda and teaches in the shadow of the colonnades
Chapter 6	Walking on water	John 6:16-21	Jesus feeds the 5,000 and walks on water
Chapter 7	7 "Feasts"	John 7:37-38	Jesus celebrates "Feast of Tabernacles" and teaches in the temple where the leaders are skeptical
Chapter 8	Woman in Hourglass	John 8:3-11	Story of Jesus not condemning the woman caught in adultery, daring the teachers and Pharisees to "cast the first stone"; the picture also shows an "A" to depict all of Jesus' "I Am" statements;
Chapter 9	An eye	John 9:5-7	Jesus heals the man born blind by putting mud in his eyes.
Chapter 10	Door handle	John 10:7-9	The "door" to the sheep pen; Jesus is the good Shepherd and the gatekeeper; we are His sheep;
Chapter 11	Grave clothes	John 11:38-44	The story of Lazarus being raised from the dead
Chapter 12	"2" as hair	John 12:3-8	Jesus is anointed by Mary with perfume that she wipes on his feet with her hair
Chapter 13	Toe separator	John 13:4-10	Jesus washes his disciples' feet
Chapter 14	Multiple roads	John 14:6	"I am the way, the truth and the life" - Jesus is clear with his disciples about who he is
Chapter 15	Vines	John 15:1-2	"I am the vine, you are the branches" - Jesus continues his teaching with his disciples
Chapter 16	Dove & nest	John 16:7-11	Jesus explains the coming of the Holy Spirit, the "Advocate," to his disciples
Chapter 17	Praying hands	John 17:1-26	This entire chapter is known as Jesus' "High Priestly Prayer"
Chapter 18	Handcuffs	John 18:12-13	Jesus is betrayed by Judas and arrested;
Chapter 19	Cross	John 19:16-18	Jesus is sentenced and crucified; this chapter also includes his burial
Chapter 20	Stone & Open tomb	John 20:1-9	The empty tomb! Jesus appears both to Mary, to the disciples and then to Thomas;
Chapter 21	Fish and 2+1=3	John 21:4-17	Jesus tells disciples to fish on the other side of the boat; he has breakfast on the shore and asks Peter three times "Do you love me?"
